ELIGIBILITY Eligible two dimensional media include painting, drawing, printmaking, pastel and mixed media. **Sculpture, photography and digital art are not eligible.** Work may not exceed 36" in height or width, not including frame. Bowery accepts applications from outside the U.S.

SALES All work will be for sale unless the artist informs the gallery to the contrary. All proceeds from sales will go to the artist.

FEES \$35.00 entry fee allows each artist to submit 1-3 images. Additional images may be submitted for an extra \$6.00 per image. Maximum submission: 6 images. Entry fees are paid through the entry form's Paypal link, which accepts credit cards.

SUBMISSION Work will be juried from images submitted only through the gallery's online submission form accessible at: www.bowerygallery.org/juried.html. Images must be JPGs with minimum width/height of 1000px, maximum size 3MB. Please do not use spaces or special characters (such as @/!"):#;%&\$) in image file names. An embedded color profile is recommended for accurate color.

DEADLINE All applications must be submitted before midnight on April 23, 2023. Bowery Gallery will make every effort to notify all applicants of juror's decision by June 1, 2023.

Cohen is also the founder and moderator of The Review Panel, an ongoing public discussion forum which he launched in 2004, and has been hosted by the National Academy Museum, the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts, and the Brooklyn Public Library. He has taught at Pratt Institute, the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts, and the Fashion Institute of Technology.
